

POVENTURE GLOBE

Want to be part of the Go Jetter Academy?
You can with your very own papier mache globe!

Step by step we'll show you how to make one from a humble styrofoam ball.





Gather your supplies.

You will need:

- scissors
- brush
- glue
- styrofoam ball
- Coloured tissue paper (blue, white and green)



Begin by gluing pieces of blue tissue paper all over the styrofoam ball to represent the oceans. Use a variety of blue tissue tones to create a nice texture. Leave aside to dry.




Next gently glue pieces of green tissue paper to represent the continents/land.



Use white tissue paper to represent the Antarctica.

Ubercorn Funky Fact: Antarctica is the coldest continent; temperatures in the winter can drop below -73° C (- 100° F).







Decorate the globe with the landmarks and use the location stars to mark all the places where the Go Jetters have been.
